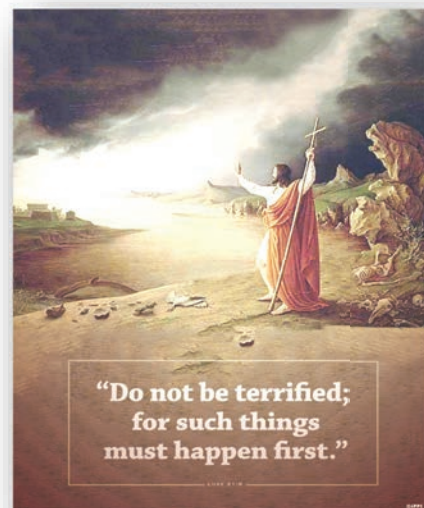

### STORIES THAT UPLIFT

Luke 21:5-19

#### 33<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time - Year C

Fiorello LaGuardia was mayor of New York City during the Depression, and he was quite a character. He would ride the city fire trucks, take entire orphanages to baseball games, and whenever the city newspapers went on strike, he would get on the radio and read the Sunday “funnies” to the children.

At any rate, one bitter cold winter’s night in 1935, Mayor LaGuardia turned up in a night court that served the poorest ward in the city, dismissed the judge for the evening, and took over the bench himself. After he heard a few cases, a tattered old woman was brought before him, accused of stealing a loaf of bread.

She told LaGuardia that her daughter’s husband had deserted her, her daughter was sick, and her grandchildren were starving. But the shopkeeper, from whom the bread was stolen, insisted on pressing charges. “My store is in a very bad neighborhood, your honor,” he said. “She has got to be punished in order to teach other people a lesson.”

The mayor sighed. He turned to the old woman and said, “I have got to punish you,” he said. “The law makes no exception—ten dollars or ten days in jail.” But even as he spoke, LaGuardia was reaching into his pocket and pulling out a ten-dollar bill. “Here is the woman’s fine,” he said, “and furthermore, I am going to fine everyone in this court room fifty cents for living in a city where a person has to steal bread so that her grandchildren can eat. Mr. Bailiff, collect the fines and give them to the defendant.”

The following day, the New York Times reported that \$47.50 was turned over to the bewildered old woman. It was given by the red-faced store owner, some seventy petty criminals, people with traffic violations, and city policemen—and they all gave their mayor a standing ovation as they handed over their money.

## Saint Rose Philippine Duchesne

1769-1852

FEAST DAY: NOVEMBER 18

**G**rowing up in a prosperous French family, Philippine joined the Visitation nuns, but returned to her family during the French Revolution. In 1804 she entered the Society of the Sacred Heart. After much preparation, she led a missionary journey to Missouri in 1818. She set up the first free school west of the Mississippi, Sacred Heart houses and Novitiate, and a school for Indians. Despite frontier hardships and ill health, she persevered in her early dream of serving Native Americans.

## *Reflections on the Readings from the 33<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time - November 13, 2022*

### PERSEVERANCE IN TIME OF TRIAL

In this week's Gospel reading, Jesus speaks of scary things--wars, famines, persecution, plagues, earthquakes, and signs falling from the skies. Yet in the midst of his warnings about the judgment coming on earth and the persecution his followers will face, Jesus exhorts his disciples, "By your perseverance you will secure your lives."

Perseverance is the key. Will the disciples remain faithful to Jesus when their faith is tested most—when they face trials, sufferings, and even persecution? For first-century Christians who might be hated for the sake of their faith in Christ, the words of Jesus would provide reassurance and hope. Jesus will always strengthen and comfort those who persevere in faith. And we can rest in this same hope today.

Just as the early Christians persevered in times of trial, so too are we called to persevere in the daily crosses the world might inflict upon Christ's followers today. While not all of us are called to literally die for the faith like the early Christian martyrs did, we all are called to die to ourselves in many little ways each day through the sacrifices we make for our faith and by persevering through the misunderstanding, ridicule, and even hostility we might face for remaining faithful to Christ in our secular world today.

### PRAYER

Prayerfully consider the words of Jesus in today's Gospel passage: "By your perseverance, you will secure your lives." Imagine Jesus speaking those words specifically to you. To what situation in your life right now might Jesus' exhortation for you to persevere in faith apply the most? Is there a certain trial or difficulty in your life where you are wavering in your trust in the Lord? How might perseverance in faith and greater trust in God help you find greater security in your life?

### RESOLUTION

In prayer, consider that particular area of your life where you are struggling. Ask Jesus to show you at least one specific way you can live out his teaching to persevere in faith in that area, and ask him for the grace to help you to do that this week. | [formed.org](https://formed.org)
