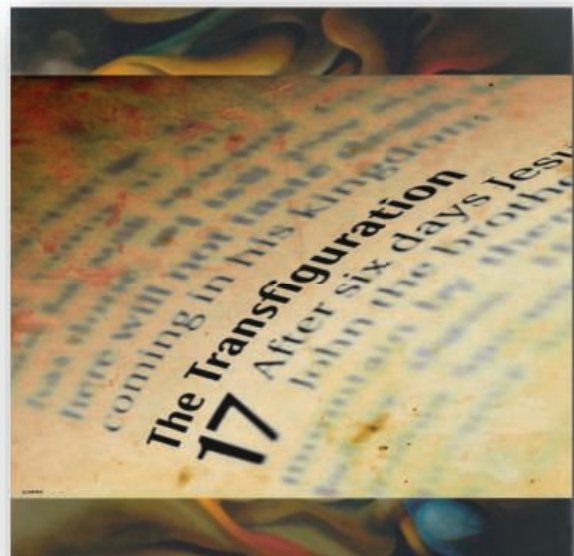

EUCCHARISTIC MIRACLES EXHIBIT

This traveling exhibit was created to assist those who will experience it to affirm belief in the Real Presence of the Jesus in the Eucharist. It is based upon the website created by **Blessed Carlo Acutis** to catalogue all of the eucharistic miracles that have taken place worldwide. Acutis was a young man who lived in Italy. In his short life he was especially interested in web design and computer technology. He died at age 15 in 2006, and was beatified in 2020.

Acutis's exhibit is circular and is divided into seven sections or rooms. In the first six rooms, information about the Eucharistic miracles is displayed. Each panel names a miracle, recounts the story of its occurrence and the country where it took place. The panels are arranged in chronological order from the early Third Century to 2013. Be sure to notice the date on the timeline and some of the world events that will help you to place the miracle within an historical era.

All of the rooms point to the center of the exhibit. This is to intentionally remind us that the historical miracles we are learning about on the walls of the exhibit are all pointing to the miracle in front of us ☐ Jesus, present in the Most Holy Eucharist! In the seventh room, the Eucharist is clearly visible in the monstrance and a place has been prepared for you to rest a while in His presence.

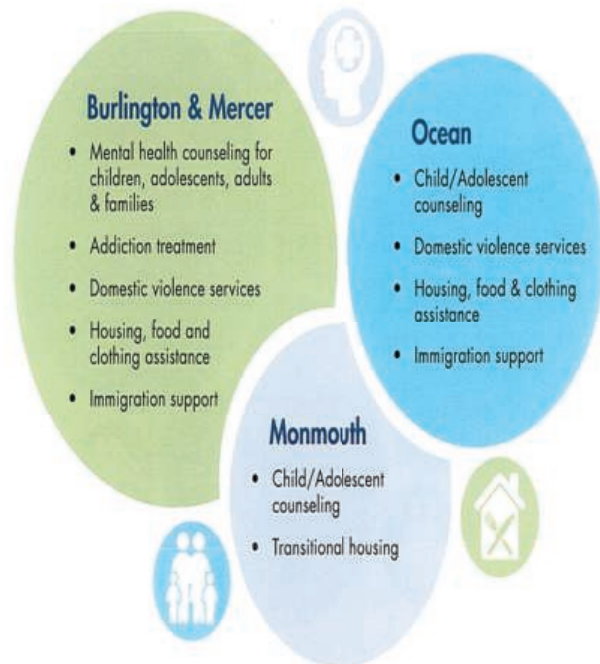

SAINT TERESA BENEDICTA OF THE CROSS



Born into a prominent Jewish family in Breslau, Germany—now Wroclaw, Poland—Edith abandoned Judaism in her teens and stopped believing in God. As a brilliant student at the University of Göttingen, Edith earned a doctorate in philosophy in 1916.

Edith Stein was so captivated by reading the autobiography of Teresa of Avila that she began a spiritual journey that led to her baptism in the Catholic Church in 1922. Twelve years later she imitated Saint Teresa by becoming a Carmelite nun, taking the name Teresa Benedicta of the Cross.

After living for four years in the Cologne Carmel, Sister Teresa Benedicta moved to the Carmelite monastery in Echt, Netherlands, in 1938. The Nazis occupied that country in 1940. In retaliation for being denounced by the Dutch bishops, the Nazis arrested all Dutch Jews who had become Christians. Teresa Benedicta and her sister Rosa, also a Catholic, died in a gas chamber in Auschwitz on August 9, 1942.

Pope John Paul II beatified Teresa Benedicta of the Cross in 1987 and canonized her 12 years later.

The writings of Edith Stein fill 17 volumes, many of which have been translated into English. A woman of integrity, she followed the truth wherever it led her. After becoming a Catholic, Edith continued to honor her mother's Jewish faith. Sister Josephine Koepfel, O.C.D., translator of several of Edith's books, sums up this saint with the phrase, "Learn to live at God's hands."

FIX IT PROGRAM

The **Fix It Program** assists residents of Ocean County who are 60 years of age or older by performing minor home repairs, which if neglected, would adversely affect their health and/or safety. The program's dedicated volunteers provide all services **FREE** of charge. However, residents, must pay for materials. The **Fix It Program** is made possible through grants from the Ocean County Office of Senior Services and is registered with the Volunteer Center of Ocean County.

- TYPES OF PROJECTS FIX IT VOLUNTEERS TAKE ON**
- Install grab bars and safety hand rails
 - Repair minor electrical problems (such as faulty light switches)
 - Do minor carpentry repairs
 - Do minor plumbing (such as leaky faucets and running toilets)
 - Change storm windows and doors
 - Weather stripping and caulking
 - Replace batteries in smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors
 - Change light bulbs
 - Change furnace filters and air conditioner filters
 - Install curtain and drapery hardware
 - Fix small appliances
 - Perform seasonal outside jobs (based upon volunteer availability)



Reflections on the Transfiguration of the Lord - August 6, 2023

IT IS GOOD THAT WE ARE HERE

All four of today's Scripture readings focus on the glory and majesty of Jesus as king. His glorious kingship is foretold by the prophet Daniel in the vision he receives as "one like a Son of man" receiving an everlasting dominion from God, the "Ancient One." In the Responsorial Psalm we sing to our Lord who is king over all the earth. In the second reading of St. Peter, we actually get a firsthand account from Peter of what we hear about again in the Gospel reading from St. Matthew--the glory and majesty that Peter witnessed on the Mount of the Transfiguration.

Together all these Scripture passages point toward the divinity of Jesus Christ, one of the most important points of our faith as Christians. This key doctrine is also a great mystery. How can Jesus be fully God and fully man? What does that mean? How well do we understand this claim? Can we explain it and defend it?

These are all important questions and great topics for further study--but today we step aside from our struggle to understand and seek to just be with God. The Transfiguration was a moment of glory and strength before the scandal and horror of the Cross.

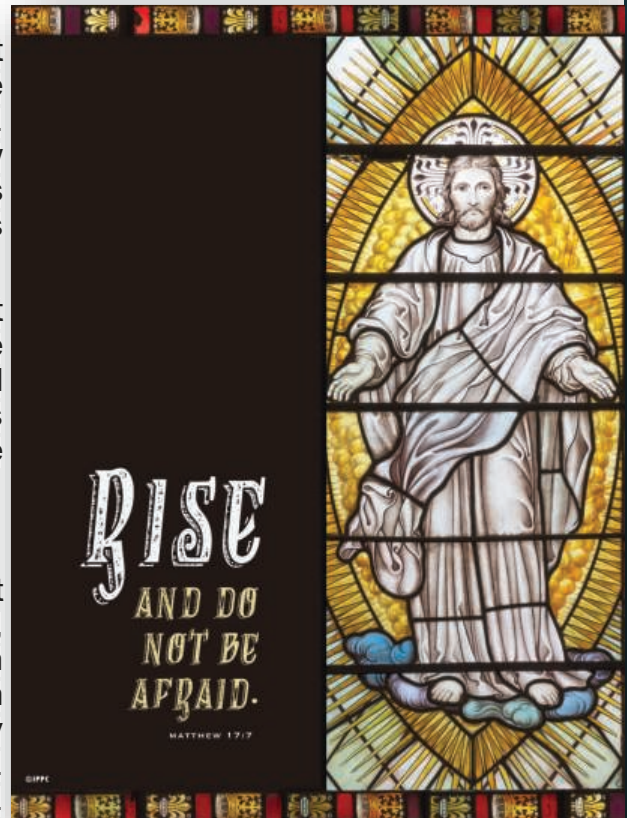
PRAYER

Peter, James, and John were Jesus's most intimate friends. They had traveled with him, learned from him, ate with him, and (we can assume) laughed with him for three years. But on the mountaintop they witnessed something totally beyond their years of experience with Jesus. Prayerfully put yourself in this Gospel reading. What are your expectations as you climb the mountain with Jesus? How do you feel when you see him transfigured and see his glory revealed? What do you think when you hear the voice of the Father speaking from the cloud, "This is my beloved son. Listen to him!"?

RESOLUTION

God in all his glory dwells within the hearts of the faithful. He comes to us in the Eucharist at each and every Mass--his glory is veiled, but it is still fully present. This is a great and beautiful mystery of our Faith.

Peter may not have fully understood what he witnessed and heard at the Transfiguration but he did recognize the importance of being in Jesus's presence. Ask God if there are any areas in your life where something is getting in the way of simply being present with him. Surrender those obstacles to God in prayer. Each day this week, try to be more aware of God's glorious presence with you. formed.org
