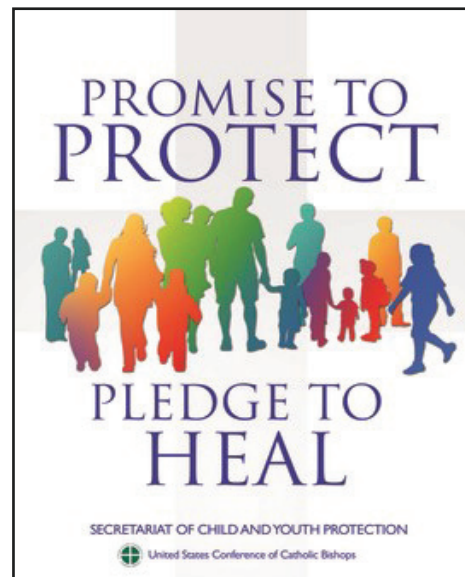

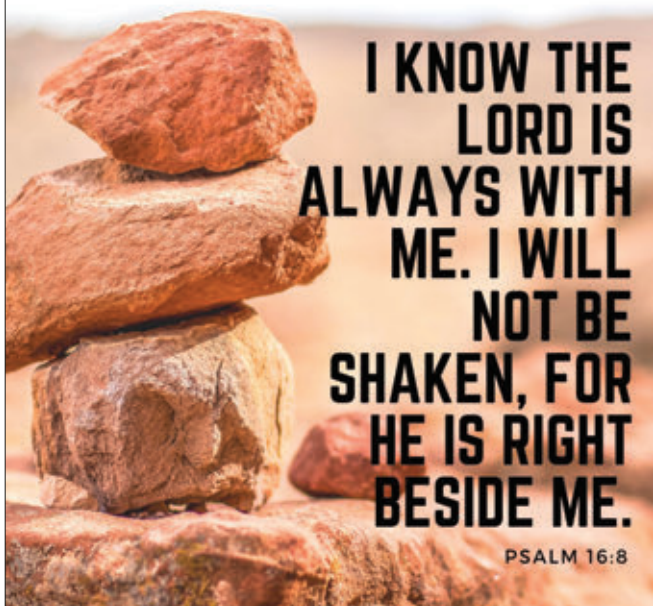
## HOW TO BECOME CATHOLIC

As you move forward through prayer, reflection, Scripture reading, storytelling, questioning, worshiping, and performing works of charity, RCIA members, along with the parish community, will accompany you on your faith journey. ## THE THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER



Parents play the primary role in educating their children about sexual abuse. Here are 5 tips for teaching safety to the little ones God has entrusted to you:

**1: Keep it practical.**

Teach your children the differences between safe touches and unsafe touches.

**2: Tell your children that saying “no” is okay.**

Empower your children to say “no” if anyone makes them feel uncomfortable or touches them inappropriately.

**3: Give your children a way to alert you.**

Tell your children they can use an excuse or share a special “code-word” with you to alert you about an unsafe person or situation.

**4: Tell your children to report an unsafe touch.**

Let your children know they should tell you if they feel uncomfortable or unsafe around any adult or peer. You can also identify other adults they can tell about unsafe touches.

**5: Tell your children you trust them.**

If your child makes a report to you, believe him or her. Tell them it is not their fault and that you love them. Immediately bring the allegation to the attention of public authorities.

## A PLACE OF ENCOUNTER

A meal with Jesus Christ, himself. What would it be like if Jesus asked to share dinner with you and your family tonight? To start with, how would you dress? What would you serve? How would you prepare your home? Beyond that, what would you discuss? What would you share with him, and what do you think he would say in response?

Each Sunday Jesus invites you to share a meal with him—to encounter him in the most intimate of ways. How do you approach the Mass? Do you show up late, wearing what you worked in all day, and with your laundry list of “to-do’s” on your mind? Jesus wants to encounter us and touch our hearts every time we meet him in the Eucharist. Take some time this week to reconsider the invitation of the Mass.

## PRAYER

In today’s Gospel, Jesus reveals himself to his disciples. They do not recognize him at first, and so he meets them in a way that they can really see him. Take some time to reflect on the moments in your life that you do not recognize Jesus. What keeps you from seeing him?

It is easy to be distracted during the Mass. Our mind wanders, and we forget why we are there and who’s presence we are in. Jesus gives us the profound privilege of not only hearing his Word each time we attend Mass, but even more strikingly, the opportunity to touch and be nourished by his Body and Blood. Reflect on how you can prepare your heart and mind to meet Christ in a personal way this week during Mass. How will you respond when he offers you the opportunity to “touch” him?

## RESOLUTION

Take time to prepare for Mass this week. Read through next Sunday’s readings ahead of time so that you are able to engage your mind during the readings and homily. Arrive ten minutes early to Mass and remain at your seat to pray and thank God for the gift of encountering him in the Eucharist for five minutes after Mass ends. Challenge yourself to pay attention to the words you say in Mass, *praying it* rather than nonchalantly repeating words you have memorized. | [formed.org](http://formed.org)

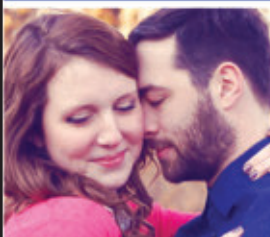
